

Boulders Fall Short vs Capitales Drop Rubber Game of Series

Pomona, NY – The Boulders never led the defending Frontier League champions Thursday night at Clover Stadium, dropping a 7-5 decision to Québec as the Capitales took two of three in the series.

New York (16-13) did battle back from 3-0 down with a run in the fourth inning on LF **John Schroeder**'s RBI double, then tied the score in the bottom of the fifth as 2B **Kyle Hess** had an RBI single and DH **Jason Agresti** added a ribby double.

But the tie was short lived, as Québec (22-7) scratched out a run in the sixth, scored another in the seventh, and plated two more in the eighth, building a 7-3 lead before Agresti's two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth inning accounted for the final margin.

The Boulders open a quick three-game road trip up in the Capital District against the Tri-City ValleyCats tomorrow (Friday) night, with first pitch set for 6:30pm EDT.

Also of note:

* Hess has reached base at least once in all 13 games played since returning from IR

* Agresti (3-for-3, 2 runs, 3 RBI) collected his third straight multi-hit game and is now 8-for-16 over a four-game hitting streak ... he's also 17-of-41 (.415) so far in June
