

## **Boulders Lose Opener at Tri-City** Drop Second Straight Game

**UNDATED** – The Boulders were shut out until the ninth inning Friday night in Troy, NY, where they lost the series opener against the Tri-City ValleyCats 6-1 at Joseph L. Bruno Stadium.

New York (16-14) fell behind early on for the third game in a row, this time when Tri-City (11-18) scored two runs in the bottom of the first inning on back-to-back sacrifice flies off of LHP **Garrett Peters** (L, 0-3 / 5 IP, 3 R, 6 H, 1 BB, 1 K).

The home team added single runs in the fifth and seventh, then capped their night with two more in the eighth for a 6-0 lead.

The Boulders finally found the scoreboard in the top of the ninth, when DH **Jason Agresti** drilled a two-out solo homer that ended a stretch of 16 straight New York batters retired.

The middle of the three-game series is set for a 6:30pm EDT first pitch tomorrow (Saturday) night at "The Joe," where the Boulders have now lost six in a row.

Also of note:

\* 2B **Kyle Hess** (3<sup>rd</sup> inning) has reached base at least once in all 14 games played since returning from IR

\* Agresti (2-for-4) racked up his fourth straight multi-hit game and is now 10-for-20 over a five-game hitting streak ... he's also 19-of-45 (.422) so far in June
