

Boulders Fall Again at Tri-City Lose Third in a Row

UNDATED – For the third time in the last six games, the Boulders failed to close out a contest which they led by five runs or more, falling in Troy, NY, to the Tri-City ValleyCats on Saturday night at Joseph L. Bruno Stadium 13-5.

New York (16-15) built a 5-1 cushion with three runs in the third inning and two in the fourth, capped by CF **Julian Boyd**'s first home run as a Boulder – a two-run shot against his former teammates on a night he reached base three times and scored twice.

RHP **Garrett Cooper** (ND / 5 IP, 4 R, 9 H, 1 BB, 0 K) left after five innings with the score 5-4, but had to settle for a no-decision when the ValleyCats (12-18) erupted for five runs in the bottom of the seventh – highlighted by a script-flipping two-run double from David Glancy and former Boulder Jake Reinisch's back-breaking three-run homer.

The home team tacked on four more runs in the eighth, with Glancy's two-run homer providing the cherry on top of a six-RBI performance.

The Boulders have dropped three straight games and five of six, tying their coldest snap of the season. They'll try to salvage the series finale tomorrow (Sunday) evening, with pitch at "The Joe" scheduled for 5:00pm EDT.

Also of note:

* Agresti (2-for-3, walk, sac fly) made it five straight multi-hit games and is now 12-for-23 (.522) over a six-game hitting streak ... he's also 21-of-48 (.438) so far in June

* LF **John Schroeder** (1-for-4, walk, RBI) extended his hitting streak to six games (8-for-23 / .348)
