

Boulders Blown Out By Down East Give Up Most Runs Since 2023

Pomona, NY – Boulders 1B **Jason Agresti** went 2-for-4 and racked up his eighth consecutive multi-hit game, but the Down East Bird Dawgs scored the most runs against New York (19-16) in three years, taking the middle game of the series 16-1 on Wednesday night at Clover Stadium.

The Bird Dawgs (16-19) posted the most lopsided win of their two-year existence, erupting for eight runs in the top of the second inning against RHP **Emmett Bice** (L, 2-1 / 1.1 IP, 8 R, 5 H, 6 BB, 1 K), taking full advantage of six walks, including four with the bases loaded.

Agresti also did his part to save the Boulders' bullpen, pitching a career-high three innings in only the third mound appearance of his professional career (also 2024 for Lake Erie (1 IP) and 2019 with New Jersey (1 IP)), while extending his overall hitting streak to nine games (18-for-36).

A sacrifice fly by LF **John Schroeder** in the bottom of the sixth plated SS **Fritz Genther** with the home team's only run.

The rubber game of Down East's final visit this season is set for a 7:00pm EDT first pitch tomorrow (Thursday) night.

Also of note:

* Agresti is 17-for-32 (.531) over his last eight games and is batting .443 (27-for-61) in the month of June

* Schroeder extended his hitting streak to nine games (13-33 / .394) with a 9th inning single

* DH **Kyle Hess** had a 7th inning single, reaching base for the 17th consecutive game he's played since coming off the injured list
