

## **Boulders Fall in Finale vs. Aigles** Have to Settle for Series Split

**Pomona, NY** – The Boulders wound up 2-2 on the weekend after dropping their series finale to the Trois-Rivières Aigles 8-3 on Sunday afternoon at Clover Stadium.

New York (21-18) grabbed a 1-0 lead in the first inning on DH **Jason Agresti's** sacrifice fly, then rallied from 2-1 down with two runs in the bottom of the fifth; LF **Norris McClure** slugged a game-tying leadoff homer, while RF **Aaron Simmons** added an RBI single.

That 3-2 advantage was also short lived, as the Aigles (12-26) got a sixth inning ribby single from SS Lizandro Rodriguez, who'd belted a solo homer in the fifth.

3B John Montes capped his six-RBI weekend with a tie-breaking single off RHP **Jalon Long** (L, 2-1) in the top of the eighth to make it 4-3 T-R, and the visitors put the cherry on top of their Father's Day sundae with four runs in the ninth; C Jedier Hernandez had a two-run double before Rodriguez capped his best game of the year with a two-run single.

After an off-day tomorrow (Monday), the Boulders embark on their longest road trip so far in 2026; three games apiece at Tri-City, Québec, and Sussex County.

First pitch vs. the ValleyCats is scheduled for 6:30pm EDT Tuesday at Joseph L. Bruno Stadium (aka "The Joe") in Troy, NY.
