

Boulders Finish First-Ever Sweep at Tri-City Roll to Rain-Shortened 6-Inning Win

UNDATED – The Boulders completed their first-ever three-game sweep at Joseph L. Bruno Stadium (aka “The Joe”) in Troy, NY, leading the Tri-City ValleyCats (15-24) wire-to-wire in a rain-shortened 7-2 win. The game was halted in the top of the seventh inning and did not resume.

New York (24-18) is six games over .500 for the first time since moving to 10-4 on May 26 after scratching out a run in the top of the first inning on DH **Jason Agresti**'s RBI groundout, then three in the second for a 4-0 lead -- 3B **Norris McClure** delivered a two-run double, and CF **Julian Boyd** added an RBI single -- before Boyd's two-run double highlighted the Boulders' three-run top of the sixth.

LHP **Ethan Bradford** (W, 3-1 / 1.1 IP, 0 R, 1 H, 0 BB, 2 K) earned the win in relief, following RHP **Scott Harper** (1 IP, 1 R, 3 H, 0 BB, 0K) and fellow lefty **Caiden Johnson** (3.2 IP, 1 R, 2 H, 6 BB, 2 K), who got the start in his Boulders debut after being acquired from Ottawa in last week's Dan Tauken trade.

The Boulders continue their longest road trip of the season so far with a visit to the four-time defending Frontier League champion Québec Capitales starting tomorrow (Friday) night at Stade Canac, where first pitch is scheduled for 7:05pm EDT.

Also of note:

* The Boulders scored 4 runs in the top of the 7th that wound up being erased from the scorebook because the inning was not completed

* The last time NY had swept a three-game series vs. Tri-City was August 26-28, 2022, in Pomona
