

Boulders Roll to Seventh Straight Win Erupt for 7 Runs Top of 9th in Sussex

UNDATED – The Boulders have won seven games in a row for the first time since early last June after rolling over the Sussex County Miners 12-4 Tuesday night at Skylands Stadium in Augusta, NJ.

New York (28-18) broke open a close game with seven runs in the top of the ninth inning, highlighted by SS **Fritz Genter**'s RBI double that make it 6-4 – his first run driven in since June 16th.

DH **Jason Agresti** started the scoring with a solo homer in the first, then collected the final ribby of the night when he beat out an infield single.

LHP **Isaac Rohde** (W, 3-1 / 6 IP, 4 R, 9 H, 3 BB, 4 K) won his third straight decision, while RHP's **Anthony Leak**, **Jalon Long**, and **Tyler Vail** went an inning apiece, combining to allow just one hit and a walk while striking out two,

The Boulders are 4-0 this season against the Miners (19-25) and have taken 12 in a row against their neighbors from northwest New Jersey since last July 2nd.

They're also a season-best 10 games over .500, 7-0 so far on their nine-game road trip, and have won eight straight on the road overall.

The series continues tomorrow (Wednesday) night in Augusta, with first pitch scheduled for 7:05pm EDT.

Also of note:

* RF **Aaron Simmons** and 1B **Kyle Hess** combined to draw seven of the team's ten walks

* 2B **Santino Rosso** (2-for-5, RBI, run) is 17-of-38 / .447 over a 9-game hitting streak

* 3B **Norris McClure** (2-for-5, 3 RBI, run) and CF **Julian Boyd** (2-for-4, RBI, run) both extended their hitting streaks to 8 games; Boyd's 14-for-29 (.483), while McClure is 12-for 33 (.364)
