

Boulders Hold Off Aigles Take Series Opener in Return Home

Pomona, NY – The Boulders kicked off their final home stand before the Frontier League All-Star Break with a 5-3 win over the Trois-Rivières Aigles on Friday night at Clover Stadium.

New York (29-20) opened a 5-0 lead in the 2nd inning, highlighted by C **John Schroeder's** two-run double and an RBI double by 3B **Norris McClure**, who extended his hitting streak to 11 games.

LHP **Garrett Peters** (W, 3-2 / 5 IP, 0 R, 7 H, 1 BB, 5 K) won his third straight start, while RHP **Tyler Vail** (Save #5) stranded the bases loaded in the top of the ninth inning to nail down the Boulders' 17th homefield win of 2026 (17-10).

Trois-Rivières (15-32) scored all of their runs in the top of the seventh off LHP **Ethan Bradford**, whose one-out bobble loaded the bases and led to CF Justin Farmer's two-run double before DH Emmanuel Tapia added a run-scoring groundout.

The teams will celebrate the Fourth of July with another 6:30pm EDT first pitch on Saturday, then close out Independence Day weekend with a Sunday doubleheader starting at 3:00pm EDT.

Also of note:

* McClure (2-for-4) is 17-of-43 (.395) over his hot stretch and 6-15 the last 4 games

* DH **Jason Agresti** (1-for-2, walk, HBP) extended his latest hitting streak to eight games (14-33 / .424) with a first inning, first pitch single
