

Boulders Split Sunday Doubleheader Win 4-Game Series vs. Trois-Rivières

Pomona, NY – The Boulders closed out their final home stand before the Frontier League All-Star Break with a come-from-behind 3-2 win over les Aigles de Trois-Rivières (16-34) in Game Two of their Sunday doubleheader at Clover Stadium.

SS Fritz Genther delivered a game-tying one-out RBI triple in the bottom of the sixth inning, then scored the go-ahead run on a wild pitch.

RHP Jalon Long (W, 4-1) earned the win after striking out two in a perfect frame of relief, while **RHP Tyler Vail** (Save # 6) worked around a one-out walk in the seventh, nailing down his sixth save of the year on a nicely turned 3-6-3 double play between 1B **Jason Agresti** and Genther.

LHP Alex Barker (4 IP, 1 R, 3 H, 2 BB, 4 K) wound up with a no-decision in his return from the injured list.

New York (31-21) took three of four this weekend by overcoming a 1-0 deficit on CF **Julian Boyd's** leadoff homer in the third, then rallied again after falling behind 2-1 in the top of the fifth.

Game One of the twin-bill saw the Boulders climb out of a 3-0 first inning hole with five runs in the bottom half, but Trois-Rivières scored a run in the fifth and regained the lead for good with a five-spot in the top of the sixth.

The home team had the tying run up twice after scoring twice in the bottom of the seventh, but the rally fell short.

After an off day tomorrow (Monday), the Boulders open a six-game visit to the Down East Bird Dawgs in Kinston, North Carolina – the final series of the proverbial first half of the season. First pitch Tuesday night at Grainger Stadium is set for 7:00pm EDT.

* Agresti, Long, and 2B **Santino Rosso** were all voted to the Frontier League All-Star Game --- Agresti (3rd time overall) and Long for the 2nd year in a row and Rosso for the 1st time
