

## **Marc-Antonie Lebreux Walk-Off Grand Slam Beats Brockton 6-5**

**QUEBEC, CA** – Quebec salvaged a victory in game three when Marc-Antoine Lebreux hit a walk-off grand slam with two outs in the bottom of the 9th, leading Quebec to a 6-5 victory over Brockton on Sunday evening at Stade Canac.

Brockton's starting pitcher, Pierce Williams, made his professional baseball debut. He took a no-decision he pitched 3.2 innings, giving up four hits and two earned runs while walking one batter and striking out four. Mike McKenna took the loss, dropping to 2-3 on the season after pitching 0.2 innings, allowing four earned runs, walking three batters, and striking out one.

Quebec's starting pitcher Harley Gollert also took a no decision. Going 6.2 innings, giving up five hits and three earned runs while striking out eight batters. Cole Roland earned his first win of the year for Les Capitales, throwing a scoreless top of the 9th.

Quebec struck first in the bottom of the second inning when Marc-Antoine Lebreux walked, stole second, and then advanced to third on a wild pitch. Jarrod Belbin contributed with a sacrifice fly to center fielder Austin White, giving Quebec a 1-0 lead.

In the top of the fourth, Brockton took the lead when left fielder Tommy Kretzler hit a two-run home run, putting the Rox ahead 2-1. In the bottom of the fourth, Justin Gideon led off with a double, and Kyle Crowl followed with a single, putting two runners on base for Will Riley, who tied the game at 2-2 with an RBI single.

Mike McKenna came in relief in the ninth as the Rox were three outs away from sweeping Les Capitales on their home turf; something that has not happened since Quebec joined the Frontier League. McKenna was able to get the first two outs with only one baserunner, but then consecutive walks loaded the bases for Marc-Antoine Lebreux, who hit a walk-off grand slam to give the victory for Quebec as they salvaged the series finale.

Brockton will begin a six-game homestand this upcoming Tuesday when they face the Ottawa Titans. First pitch is scheduled for 7:00 P.M. at Campanelli Stadium.
