

WASHINGTON, P.A. - The New Jersey Jackals (21-44) fell to the Washington Wild Things (37-30) 11-1.

Washington struck first with two unearned tallies in the first inning. Ben Watson reached on an error and came in to score on a Tommy Caufield double. Later in the frame, Caufield scored on a Wagner Lagrange single, growing the lead to 2-0.

The Jackals sliced the gap in half on a Sam Angelo single that plated Richel Del Rosario.

Leading 2-1, Washington erupted for four runs in the home third. Lagrange knocked Caufield in for the second time. The next hitter, Jeff Liquori singled, driving in Tyreque Reed. Leading 4-1, Cole Fowler brought in both Lagrange and Reed to grow the lead to 6-1.

The Wild Things tacked on five total runs in the seventh and eighth frames to balloon the advantage to 11-1.

Jalon Long (L, 4-5) took the loss, tossing five innings and allowing six runs with seven strikeouts. Sebastian Rodriguez (W, 2-1) earned the win after throwing seven innings, allowing one run with five strikeouts.

The Jackals resume their series in Washington tomorrow night. First pitch is scheduled for 6:05 p.m. ET.
