

Boulders Roll to Third Straight Win

Off to Best Start in Frontier League Era

Pomona, NY — The Boulders (3-1) racked up their third consecutive victory, doubling up the Ottawa Titans, 8-4, in the first of a three-game series at Clover Stadium.

New York is off to its best start since 2017, when the then-Rockland Boulders started 7-0 in Can-Am League play.

The current edition of the ball club rallied from 3-0 down, scratching out two runs in the bottom of the fourth inning on RBI singles by C **Jack Scanlon** and CF **John Schroeder**.

Ottawa (2-2) extended to a 4-2 lead in the fifth, only to see the Boulders put up three runs in the bottom of the inning; RF **Aaron Simmons** and 1B **Jason Agresti** had back-to-back leadoff doubles, LF **Dan Tauken** delivered a one-out RBI single to get starting pitcher **Isaac Rohde** off the hook (3.2 IP, 3 R, 6 H, 3 BB, 5K), and Scanlon broke the tie with a two-out ribby double.

The score stayed 5-4 until the home eighth, when Simmons blasted a three-run homer to the right-centerfield bleachers, putting the cherry on top of the School Day/Senior Day sundae.

Also of note:

- * DH **Kyle Hess** and SS **Fritz Genther** each reached base three times without a hit
- * Agresti and Tauken had three hits apiece
- * LHP **Grady Gorgen** (1-0) pitched just 1/3 of an inning, but was credited with the win
