

## **Boulders Earn Fourth Comeback Win of 2026**

### **Rally From 3-0 Down vs. Miners**

May 15, 2026

**Pomona, NY** — The Boulders were no-hit into the fifth inning, then rallied from 3-0 down with four runs in the sixth inning to edge the Sussex County Miners, 4-3, in the first of a three-game series Friday night at Clover Stadium.

New York (5-2) fell behind 1-0 in the top of the fourth, when LHP **Alex Barker** (ND / 5 IP, 1 R, 7 H, 1 BB, 3 K) gave up a two-out RBI single, then the Miners (4-3) added two runs in the sixth, aided by two Boulders errors.

Sussex County starter Bobby Parsons gave up his first hit on CF **John Schroeder's** two-out single in the bottom of the fifth, then notched his career-high 11<sup>th</sup> strikeout to end the frame.

But SS **Fritz Genther** got the home team on the board with a leadoff homer in the sixth before LF **Dan Tauken** tied it up three batters later with a two-run blast and 3B **Norris McClure** – after an infield single – came home to score the go-ahead tally when he stole third and Miners C Sandro Gaston threw the ball into left field.

LHP **Andrew Armstrong** worked around a leadoff walk and two-out hit batter in the top of the ninth to nail down his first career save, preserving RHP **Anthony Leak's** first Boulders win.

The middle game of the series is set for a 6:30 pm start tomorrow (Saturday) on STEAM and Robotics Night, with a post-game fireworks display to follow the final out.

#### **Also of note:**

\* For the fourth time this season – and second straight game -- every batter in the Boulders' starting lineup reached base at least once

\* The bullpen trio of Armstrong, RHP **Scott Harper**, and LHP **Grady Gorgen** combined for 2.1 innings of hitless and scoreless relief

\* The home runs hit by Genther and Tauken were the first for each in 2026
