Prices are effective July 13, 2026 and are subject to change without notice.

We are honored to help you and promise to provide you with caring support and guidance. In compliance with the trade regulations of the Federal Trade Commission, we are required to provide you with this General Price List for retention. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

A. Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

\$2,260

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, the following: staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement of conference with family or responsible party; consultation with family and clergy; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary notices; authorizations and consents; coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our package charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

B. Embalming

\$815

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. *Michigan law requires embalming when death was caused by certain infectious diseases or, with very limited exceptions, when the body is not taken to its final destination within 48 hours of the time of death.*

C. Care of Embalmed Decedent

Services provided may include, when necessary, but are not limited to the following circumstances: restoration; cosmetology; washing; sanitizing; disinfecting; manicuring; placement in the casket; care needed after an autopsy or gift of life procurement; refrigeration; and removal of electronic devices.

Custodial Care of the decedent beyond 14 days.

D. Care of Unembalmed Decedent

Your loved one will be prepared for cremation, anatomical donation, green burial or Terramation in a dignified manner by bathing, dressing, and when appropriate we will apply cosmetics, comb, and/or curl hair. For cremation, we will remove any battery-operated devices such as a pacemaker or defibrillator, if applicable, place your loved one in the container of choice, shelter him/her in a cool room at our funeral home prior to receiving authorization documents, place cremated remains in the selected urn and keep your loved one in our safe keeping until final plans for their cremated remains have been fulfilled.

E. Use of facilities and staff for day prior viewing/visitation (two may be hosted simultaneously)

F. Use of facilities and staff for funeral ceremony/gathering/memorial service

Monday -Friday, 11 am or 3 pm at funeral home indoors/garden/tent or offsite location.

This fee includes up to ONE hour of visitation. Visitations beyond one hour will be charged an additional \$250 fee per hour.

This is a flat fee. There is an additional fee for services located more than 30 miles from our facility.

G. Private family viewing \$275

The private family viewing allows for up to one hour for family to be with their loved one prior to going to the crematory. Family includes spouse/partner, parents, children, siblings, grandparents, grandchildren, aunts, uncles, and cousins. Private family viewing occurs within 48 hours of death between 10 am and 3 pm, Monday-Friday. This is not a public visitation.

H. Graveside service/assistance \$275

This includes a funeral director, specialist or assistant at the cemetery to assist with the burial, coordinate payment with the cemetery, deliver the burial transit permit, and ensure all takes place in accordance with state law. Some cemeteries provide chairs and a tent.

Reynolds Jonkhoff Funeral Home has a dedicated team of funeral directors that we schedule to work with families based on availability. We cannot guarantee the same director will be present for your service. However, if you would like to guarantee your director, an additional fee can be paid to do so. This fee is \$1,200 per day. If hotel costs are incurred, those charges will be added to your contract.

FORWARDING OF REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

\$2,655

This charge includes transfer of remains, basic services of funeral director and staff, embalming, and obtaining necessary authorizations. It does *not* include the services of staff or the use of facilities for any viewing, visitation, wake, family time, rites, or ceremonies prior to forwarding of remains. It does *not* include common carrier charges. Local transportation is included. If transportation exceeds 30 miles from our location, the cost of transportation (ie: airport, receiving funeral home) from our funeral home is \$4.00 per mile, one way.

RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME**\$2,660**

This charge includes receiving the remains from another funeral home, temporary sheltering of remains, obtaining necessary authorizations, transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory, and basic services of funeral director and staff. It does *not* include the services of staff or the use of facilities for any viewing, visitation, wake, family time, rites, or ceremonies after receiving the remains. It does *not* include common carrier charges. If transportation exceeds 30 miles from our location, the cost of transportation (for example to an airport or another funeral home) from our funeral home is \$4.00 per mile, one way.

RECEIVING OF CREMATED REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME**\$2,260**

This charge includes receiving the cremated remains from another funeral home, temporary sheltering of cremated remains, obtaining necessary authorizations, transportation of cremated remains to location of choice and basic services of funeral director and staff. It does *not* include the services of staff or the use of facilities for any viewing, visitation, wake, family time, rites, or ceremonies after receiving the cremated remains. You will be provided with a statement of goods and services that details any additional expenses that may be incurred. Cremated remains do not need to be present for services. Any transportation over 30 miles will be billed at \$4.00 per mile, one way.

ANATOMICAL DONATION**\$2,655**

Includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer from place of death, care of decedent, refrigeration, and obtaining all legal documents. Transfer to medical school is \$4 per mile one way.

DIRECT CREMATION**Range: \$3,715 - \$9,615**

Direct cremation includes but is not limited to the following: basic services of funeral director and staff; transfer from place of death (within 30 miles); sheltering of the remains; care of the decedent prior to cremation; transportation to the crematory; cremation processing fee; cremation permit fee required by the county; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary notices; authorizations and consents; overhead expenses. You are not required to purchase a casket for direct cremation but you may do so if you wish. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you may use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composite materials (with or without an outside covering). (The containers we provide are made of cardboard and compressed wood.) Our direct cremation charge does *not* include the use of facilities and staff for viewing, visitations, or ceremonies, or any other goods or services, except those expressly listed above.

Cremation is an irreversible process. It is important for us to make sure the final goodbyes to your loved one are comforting to you, for your peace of mind and ours. We ask that at least one member of your family identify your loved one before cremation or provide us with a photo. Embalming is not required for identification.

IMMEDIATE BURIALS**Range: \$3,420 - \$9,845**

Immediate burial includes but is not limited to the following: basic services of funeral director and staff; transfer from place of death (within 30 miles); sheltering of the remains; transportation to cemetery (within 30 miles); graveside service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary notices; authorizations and consents; and overhead expenses. The cost of transportation beyond a radius of 30 miles is \$4.00 per mile. Immediate burial charge does *not* include the use of facilities or staff for any viewing, visitation, ceremony, actual cost of a grave at the cemetery, cemetery charges, or other goods and services, except those expressly stated.

Terramation: Natural Organic Reduction**Range: \$7,000 - 10,000**

Terramation or human composting is not yet legal in the State of Michigan. Reynolds Jonkhoff Funeral Home is proud to have partnered with Return Home, a Washington based company, to offer this service. Fee includes basic services of funeral directors and staff; transfer of deceased from place of death (within 30 miles) of Reynolds Jonkhoff Funeral Home; utility vehicle; air tray; ice packs for transport; transportation to Grand Rapids airport; and the process of Terramation. Fee does *not* include airfare to Terramation facility or return of composted remains. Local memorial services, death certificates, obituaries, etc. can be added and will vary with each family. Information about Return Home and the Terramation process can be found online at returnhome.com. Range is dependent on airport selected, death certificates, and other choices your family can make.
