Jose Delgado, featured in the picture on the front row middle holding his certificate, expresses the significance of this achievement:

Meanwhile, we thank God that operations with classes at the prison have been without interruptions of COVID-19 infections since the start of this year. We continue to see an increase in applications for entrance into the program, which is a great indication that men are "thirsting" for change! Thank each one of you who through your prayers, finances, volunteering and partnership make it possible to assist our members through their transformation with God's help. I am thrilled to inform you that we have 28 of our men who have signed up to be baptized. This is an absolute praise report and evidence of a heart change!
