

December 2025 Business of the Month-GAB's Bottle In A Bag

GAB's Bottle In A Bag and GAB's 2nd Bag are owned by Gordon, Avenlee, Bryana (GAB) Gahagan. (GAB is also BAG backwards!) GAB's Bottle In A Bag was opened June 3, 2015. The building has been a liquor store since 1959, and the Gahagan's are the 3rd owners. Due to their limited knowledge of liquor, they asked customers to list items that should be stocked. They have expanded the store 3 times. The Iceberg and the Ice Cube for cold beer sales were added after the law changed in 2018. "Anyone can have a beer cave. We have an Iceberg and an Ice Cube because we aren't like everyone else. It comes complete with Aurora Borealis painted on the ceiling." The wine room was added for a much needed larger selection of wine, sparkling wine, mead, saki, soju, etc. GAB's 2nd Bag was opened when they had the opportunity to buy the old OK Liquor building. They figured they might as well be their own competition while also providing liquor service to the other side of town.

The bright yellow walls and black trim in both stores provide for a bright interior to help the bottles stand out. (The colors could also be because they are Pittsburgh Steeler fans since Gordon grew up not far from Pittsburgh.) Gordon, a drummer, came up with the decor of drum sets, stage lights, cymbal lights, and foot pedal credit card stands to display, showcase, and highlight various products around the store. The goal is to make these stores fun to visit and shop. Avenlee enjoys helping people pair products for special occasions and discussing drink recipes. Naturally the stores cannot house everything available, so Bryana is happy to try to locate special items for customers. Both stores have special order books so that customers can request items they want. GAB's Liquor helps sponsor various events in Texas county. They offer discounts on cases of items. In addition to alcohol beverages, mixers, glassware, & bar tools, They also have gift certificates available and bring in lots of different design bottles that are fun to collect or give as a gift.
