DUES, IMPORTANT REMINDERS & CONTACT INFORMATION

Dues & Payments

- Annual Dues and assessments shall be payable in full on or before March 1 of each calendar year (by-law - article v, section 4, 1.).
- Invoices will be e-mailed each year on January 5th. **Please contact the Office as soon as possible if you have not received an invoice.**
- A \$50 late fee applies after March 1. Membership dues must be paid in full by December 31, 2026, to avoid forfeiture of membership and fees.
- We accept credit cards (convenience fees apply), cash, checks, and money orders.
- Please return your completed Member info form. All information is required, including email addresses, phone numbers, birth dates, and vehicle registrations.

Important Member Reminders

MEMBERSHIP POLICIES

Gates, Security & Key Cards

- Gates close at night at 11:00 PM and reopen at 7:00 AM the following morning.
- A guard will not be on duty during overnight hours.
- Key cards are required for entry and exit during this time.
- Guests must leave the property before or at the same time as the member who signed them in.
- Lost or stolen cards should be reported immediately. Replacement or second cards are available for \$10.

Guest Policy

- Guests must be registered at the gate with a member present.
- Guests must follow all club rules and remain the responsibility of the sponsoring member.
- If you plan to host an event with 25 or more (non-member) guests, please contact the Club Office to complete the Event Request Form.

Youth Cards & Curfew

- Youth cards are for children of members ages 12–21.
- Cards must include a current photo, be signed, and laminated.
- Youth must be at least 16 years old to bring guests and must use a parent's issued guest card.
- Youth cards are collected at the gate, and sign-in/sign-out is required.

Bylaws

- **Members are responsible for understanding and following all bylaws, including newly adopted ones.** Current bylaws are available online and in printed form at the club Office and gate.

Safety

- The 5–10-mile speed limit will be enforced throughout the club. Please pay attention and watch for kids especially by the campground. Offenders are subject to violation and review by the Board.
- The entire club is no wake to all boats including pontoons and fishing boats except for speedboats with permit in the speedboat area only.
- Game wardens may access club property and are authorized to enforce the Conservation Rules.
- Per club by law, handguns are not permitted on club property.

RECREATION RULES

Dock Owners

- Docks must be maintained safely and may be inspected.
- Please notify the Office if you no longer wish to keep your dock space.

Pontoon Boats

- Proof of insurance with minimum \$500,000 liability must be on file.
- Club numbers must be displayed; boats without proper numbering may be towed.
- Boat must be registered with the State.

Ski Boats

- Boat inspections by appointment.
- Insurance proof required before entry.
- Permit holders must be present whenever the boat is in the water.
- Insurance minimum: \$500,000 for motors over 10HP.
- Eligible weekday permit holders may reserve up to 6 weekend days between June 1 and Aug 30 (Office reservations required; capacity limited).
- Wading to the end of each boat permitted; however, swimming is prohibited in the speed boat areas.
- Boat must be registered with the State

Fishing

- Please remember to register your catch at the gatehouse mailbox.
- Daily limits:
 - Bluegill -15
 - Bullhead - 12
 - Catfish - 3
 - Crappie - 10
 - Perch - 10
 - Trout - 3
 - Walleye 14" or more - 3
 - Bass 15" or under - 6 / Bass 15" and over none
 - Muskie 35" or more - 1
 - Northern – 3

RECREATION RULES

Deer Hunting (archery only)

- Members interested in Deer Hunting should submit a postcard to the office by Friday immediately preceding the 1st Sunday in June (June 5, 2026).
- Refer to the deer hunting by-law for instructions on filling out the card
- The annual deer hunting drawing and information meeting will be held on the 1st Sunday in June (June 7th, 2026) @ 9AM at the Big Pavilion.
- 35 initial permits will be drawn, and hunting locations will be chosen at the June meeting.
- Members who have submitted a postcard for deer hunting or a designated representative MUST attend the June meeting or forfeit your permit number. The annual fee will be due at this meeting. Contact Erik Frederiksen @ 815-405-8969

Spring Turkey Hunting (archery only)

- Spring Turkey Season will take place during the State of Illinois (North zone) spring turkey season.
- Interested members should send a postcard to the Area Club Office between August 1st and October 1st.
- Refer to the deer hunting by-law for instructions on filling out the card.
- A drawing will be held on the 1st Sunday in October to fill the 8 available hunting spots. It is the selected hunter's responsibility to obtain a spring turkey season permit form the state.
- The permit holders will choose designated hunting area around February 1st.

AMENITIES

Camping

- Camping season runs April 1 through December 1 each year, weather permitting.
- Camping is allowed in designated areas only.
- When registering, all campers will be given a copy of the club camping rules.

Playground/Sports Facilities

- Quiet Hours: 10:30pm on weekdays & midnight on weekends.
- Playground equipment and basketball, volleyball, and tennis/pickleball courts are open for use at your own risk. Please follow posted rules and be respectful of shared spaces.

Pavilion & Sunroom Reservations

- \$25 non-refundable deposit for one day
- Reservations available after January 1 at the Office
- Reservations are limited to one (1) day per membership each calendar year.

Pavilion #3 (Willow)

- Available 2nd and 3rd weekends only
- \$25 non-refundable deposit
- Reservations available after January 1 at the Office

Sunroom (Beach)

- \$25 non-refundable deposit for one day
- Reservations available after January 1 at the Office

Concession Stand

- Open 12 PM–5 PM from May 23 through September 7 (subject to change due to holidays, staffing availability, and weather).
- Credit and debit cards are accepted.
- Unless marked as reserved, the sunroom, located to the north of the concession stand, is open daily for anyone to use.

Ice and Vending Machines

- Ice is available at the guardhouse. Please pay on the honor system.
- Vending machines are available near the main campground bathrooms and ski beach.
