## HAYS COUNTY STOCK LAW ADOPTED OCTOBER 29, 1936

1581. County Judge W. M. Burnett and County Clerk Nannie D. Jacks, in the presence of A. M. Ramsay, Justice Peace Precinct No. One, Hays County, canvassed returns of Stock Law election, same being held October 24, A.D., 1936, to determine whether Horses, Mules, Jacks, Jennets and Cattle should be permitted to run at large in Hays County, Texas, and find that the Stock Law Carried - as follows:

STATE OF TEXAS COUNTY OF HAYS

This, the 29th day of October, 1936, came on to be tabulated and counted before and by me, the County Judge of Hays County, Texas, in the presence of the County Clerk of such county and of A. M. Ramsay, a Justice of the Peace of such county, the returns of a certain election heretofore called by the Commissioners Court of said county, to be held on the 24th day of October, 1936, to enable the freeholders of Hays County, Texas, to determine whether or not horses, mules, jacks, jennets and cattle should be permitted to run at large in said Hays County, Texas; and it appearing to me upon so tabulating and counting such returns that 403 votes were cast in favor of, and 64 votes against, the said proposition to prevent such classes of animals from running at large in said Hays County, Texas, and that such election carried in favor of such proportion by a majority of 339 votes, it is accordingly ordered that such election resulted, and it is hereby declared to be, in favor of preventing such classes of animals from running at large in said Hays County, Texas, which is to say, in favor of the Stock Law in the said Hays County, Texas.
