SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FEES

(Effective July 1st, 2017)

- **Household trash**
- \$15 CY* (\$2 minimum)
- **Construction Material**
- \$25 CY* (\$10 minimum)
- **Metal Debris** \$25 CY* (\$10 minimum)
- **Brush** \$25 CY
- **Refrigerators & Freezers (must be empty)**
Small \$20 Large \$25 (A/C units \$15 - \$25)
- **Washers, Dryers, Water heaters, BBQ, etc.**
\$10
- **Office Chair, Arm Chair, loveseat, full size sofas**
\$5, \$15, \$20, \$25 (sectionals charged per piece)
- **End Tables, Coffee Tables, Kitchen Tables**
\$10, \$20 (dressers and other large items \$25)
- **TV** \$10 - \$25
- **Mattresses (per set)**
Twin \$14 Full \$16 Queen \$20 King \$25
- **Auto Tires:**
- Off the wheel 35" less \$8
- On the wheel 35" less \$10
- **Large equipment tires – call for pricing**
- **Please note that all loads are measured unbounded and void spaces are included**

- Please be kind and courteous to other customers
- Please check-in with attendant before unloading
- Please notify attendant if bins are full
- Make sure all recyclables are rinsed and clean
- Remove lids and caps from all glass containers
- Sort all recycling into proper containers
- Corrugated cardboard must be broken down and flattened before placing in baler

Items Accepted for Recycling:

- #1 and #2 type plastic bottles only (soda/water/milk bottles)
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Glass bottles and jars
- Paper (Junk mail, newspapers, phone books, magazines, shredded paper)
- Aluminum cans
- Tin cans
- Batteries
- Motor oil
- Antifreeze
- Florescent light bulbs

Items NOT Accepted at Center

- Hazardous wastes (paints, acids, solvents, cleaners, pesticides/insecticides)
- Pool chemicals (shock, chlorine tablets, algaecides)
- Gasoline, diesel, brake fluid, transmission fluid, flammable liquids
- #3, #5, or #7 type plastic containers
- Plastic bags
