

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REQUIRING USE OF PATTERN JURY CHARGES IN CRIMINAL CASES

Pursuant to the authority vested in these Courts under the Texas Government Code, and Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, the following administrative procedures shall be implemented to promote judicial efficiency, consistency, and the orderly administration of justice in the Hays County Courts at Law.

## THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The parties shall use the Texas Criminal Pattern Jury Charges, as published by the State Bar of Texas, as the starting point for drafting the proposed jury charge.
- 2. Counsel may propose modifications, additions, or deletions to the pattern charges, provided that such changes are supported by binding precedent or applicable statutory authority.
- 3. Proposed charges (including any deviation from pattern language) shall be submitted to the Court no later than the morning of the last day of trial unless otherwise ordered.
- 4. This Order shall apply to all criminal cases set for trial on or after the effective date of this Order. This Order shall remain in effect until amended or repealed by further order of these Courts.

THIS HAYS COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REQUIRING USE OF PATTERN SHALL BECOME **EFFECTIVE** CRIMINAL CASES JURY CHARGES IN COURT THE OFFICE OF IMMEDIATELY UPON PUBLICATION ON ADMINISTRATION'S WEBSITE.
