Hays County Elections Administrator Jennifer Doinoff is proud to launch a new program for our voters: **Vote in Honor of a Veteran**. The goal of Hays County's Vote in Honor of a Veteran program is to recognize our veterans foremost and encourage voter participation by sharing with our youth the sacrifices our veterans have made for the sake of democracy. By voting, we honor veterans and service members who fight to protect our country and preserve our right to vote.

How does the program work?

To participate and vote in honor of a family member or friend who proudly served our country, please complete a short biography form, and you may also attach a **copy (not original)** of the veteran's photograph. The veteran's information can be on behalf of an active, retired, deceased, KIA, MIA, or POW veteran. The information on the biography form and the photograph will be used to display and honor the veteran. All information submitted will be displayed on our virtual honor wall (Hays County Elections Office social media pages) and in the Hays County Elections Office lobby for interested residents to view during office hours. With written permission (on the back of the biography form), the veteran's photograph and information will be posted on our social media at Hays County Elections Department Facebook, Hays_Elections_Department Instagram, and Hays County Elections Department LinkedIn.

We need your participation to make this program a success. Do I have to participate in the program to vote in honor of a veteran?

Residents do not have to take part in the program (submitting a photograph and biography form) to participate in voting in honor of a veteran. Stickers will be offered upon voting, where the voter can write the name of the veteran whom they're honoring.
