# From My Desk... The Return to Orthodox Christianity: Good for the Jews?

An article, entitled, 'A Step Back in Time': <u>America's Catholic Church sees an immense shift toward the Old Ways'</u> happened to be first in line this morning, from my "smartphone feed". The algorithm knows my penchant for reading material of "religious content".

It seems the American Catholic Church is experiencing a shift in the types of people involved in religious services, and the services themselves. One example is a church in Madison, Wisconsin. The type of music changed, preceded by the disappearance of the choir director. Now, rather than contemporary hymns, medieval types of music are played. Older Priests, who had for decades worn simple black shirts and white collars are now being replaced by young priests dressed in their full cassocks. Altar *girls* (as opposed to boys) are sometimes no longer called upon to assist.

Sermons have begun to change, as well. Priests are speaking more about the evils of abortion, and hell as terrible punishment for sin, but less about "popular" topics.

According to the National Catholic Reporter (NCR), which published this article, the Catholic world is slowly returning to an older and more Orthodox approach to its religion. It seems that the fads of the later 20<sup>th</sup> and early 21<sup>st</sup> century are disappearing, and young people (at least those who are not abandoning the Church) are seeking greater authenticity in the form of Latin masses, more frequent personal confession from sin, and traditional approaches to Christian religious services more than guitar strumming, or "rapping" priests.

To be sure, not all Catholic churches are following this path, but enough already are, so that the NCR feels confident publishing the claim that this is an "immense shift... that leaves them [these churches] sometimes at odds with Pope Francis and much of the Catholic world."

We, in the Jewish world, have noticed a similar phenomenon taking place. Orthodox Judaism, which, for much of the 20<sup>th</sup> century was considered moribund, has come roaring back since the beginning of the 21<sup>st</sup> century. The comparatively few American Orthodox families which existed from the 1950's through the 1980's brought children into the world, who, thankfully, bore many thousands more children (*Ken yirbu*- so may they continue to increase). These children, too, have grown up, and the Ortho-praxis grandchildren are now creating larger families than either their grandparents or parents. This is a welcome sign for the otherwise dwindling Jewish population of America.

Whatever a massive return to Christian Orthodoxy will ultimately mean for the Catholic Church spiritually and practically, I do not know. But, there is one jarring line in the article that makes my heart skip a beat: "...the movement....can be hard to define. It ranges from Catholics who want more incense, to Latin mass *adherents who have brought back ancient prayers that mention "the perfidious Jew"*." (Italics mine).

Whoa! There are some young priests (and it is they, after all, who sanction the prayers recited in their parish) and parishioners who are reviving Jew-hatred! This is a

reminder of what we just read in the Haggadah at our Passover Seders. "B'chol Dor Vador Omdim Aleinu l'chaloteinu""In every generation there are those who stand against us to annihilate us." If even one Catholic church reverts to
the old despicable libels, (which were eliminated by Vatican Council II in the 1960's) that is one church too many.

We Jews have worked many decades to foster respectful and friendly relations with Christians. (The International Fellowship of Christians and Jews, The Center for Christian/Jewish learning, Christians United for Israel, and the New York Board of Rabbis are excellent examples of interfaith dialogue and action.) Fortunately, at least in America, we have many established organizations which stand up powerfully for Jewish dignity. Libelous statements (e.g. "perfidious Jews") will not go unchallenged.

Whatever the direction of the Christian Church and its individual parishes, it is their decision, and I wish them well. I will support their First Amendment right to worship freely. I will continue to praise the work of the institutions mentioned above to promote peace and cooperation between Jews and Christians of this blessed country. And, I will remain vigilant and active to make sure that Jew hatred is exposed, and expunged from the prayers of any religion which claims to represent G-d's value of love for all decent human beings.






