What's it about?

This is a video series about the Eucharist from the Augustine Institute. Dr. Brant Pitre digs down to the biblical roots of the Eucharist, through its foreshadowing in the miraculous events of the Old Testament, the Gospels, and Apostolic teaching. Discover how Christ's Body and Blood are an integral and wondrous part of God's plan for our salvation.

When will it be offered?

The series is 10 sessions long, so we will be showing 5 sessions during Lent and 5 in the Fall. The series will be offered at 3 different times during each week:

- Tuesday morning 9:30 am to 11:00 am
- Tuesday evening 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm
- Thursday afternoon 1:30 pm to 3:00 pm. You can attend whatever time works for you that week. The series starts February 20th and ends March 21st.

Another option for the series is two Saturday mornings, March 9th and 23rd from 8 am to Noon. We need at least five people to sign up for this option. If we don't get five to sign up, we will not offer this option.

Is there a cost?

There is no cost to attend this series, however, we would like you to sign up if you are interested in attending. We will show the videos and then have time for discussion. However, if you want to delve deeper into the subject, you can purchase a Study Guide. The cost for the Study Guide is \$10. We need to know by February 5th if you want to purchase the Study Guide. After the 5th you can purchase the Study Guide yourself, but the cost is approximately \$25.
