A class confirmation and invoice email will be sent to you before classes begin. Please contact the studio through email if you do not receive yours. Your dancer's instructor and which studio space they are dancing in is listed on the confirmation.

CLASSES BEGIN SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 9TH-15TH.

- When arriving to the studio each week we ask that all our dancers remove their outdoor shoes and place them on the shelves provided or put them inside their dance bag (Observers can leave their shoes on)
- Dancers will bring their dance bags into class with them, if required teachers and assistant teachers will help them change their shoes.
- Dance shoes often get lost and forgotten at the studio PLEASE WRITE YOUR DANCER'S NAME in SHOES!!!
 - There is a change room downstairs in the waiting room as well as 3 bathrooms located in Steppin' Time.
 - Be sure to pack a water bottle for your dancer
 - The office is open Monday-Thursday 10:00-3:00pm if you would like to call and speak to our receptionist.
- Parking is available on 9th street or in the parking lot behind the studio, the **parking lot to the south of the studio is reserved parking owned by the City of Brandon and IS NOT for studio parking.**

Required Dance Attire

Creative Movement Only Class: Pink Ballet Slippers

Pre-School and 5+ Classes: Patented leather Tap shoes and Pink Ballet Slippers

Combination Classes of Tap and Jazz: Patented Leather Tap Shoes and Black Ballet Slippers

Combination Classes of Tap and Ballet: Patented Leather Tap Shoes and Pink Ballet Slippers

Ballet Classes: Pink Ballet Slippers

Jazz Classes: Jazz Oxford Slippers

Tap Classes: Level 2-3 Tap Cuban Heels, Levels 4 and up Oxfords (email if you are unsure what level your dancer is in)

Hip Hop: Indoor runners ONLY, comfortable, baggy clothing, no jeans (Junior, Pre-Inter, Inter, Senior and company hip hop please have black, with white sole, low top converse shoes)

Lyrical and Contemporary Classes: "Pirouette" shoe, sock or bare feet

All Boys: Comfortable clothing (Sweatpants, shorts, t-shirts) appropriate indoor shoes NO JEANS, for tap and ballet classes tap shoes and black ballet slippers or black socks

AcroDance Classes: Bodysuit and Shorts, Bare Feet, Hair in a bun and a Yoga Block

There is no specific color of bodysuit that is required for class but if you need to purchase a new one it is suggested to purchase a black tank top bodysuit. (We often use these as a base for our costumes and this will save on any extra costs.) These bodysuits can be purchased only at Pirouette Dance Wear at 121-10th street. White Tights are preferred but any color is okay.

Leggings and dance shorts are suitable for jazz and tap classes, as well as wrap skirts for ballet. All teachers will be asking the dancers to wear bodysuits and to keep your hair tied back in a ponytail or a bun.

Ballet dancers should wear only bodysuit and tights with hair tied back in a proper bun. Your instructor will specify when you can wear skirts or ballet shorts.

Adult classes: Comfortable clothing (work out clothes) with appropriate indoor shoes

DON'T FORGET TO WRITE YOUR FULL NAME IN YOUR DANCE SHOES AND ON YOUR DANCE BAG!
