



**NCASCC King & Queen Fundraising Contest
Club & District FAQ _
(including Contest Timelines)**

PURPOSE

The King & Queen Contest is a friendly fundraising competition that supports NCASCC programs while promoting teamwork, engagement, and fun among clubs and districts.

PARTICIPATION

Who can participate?

Any eligible NCASCC member selected by their club.

How many contestants per club?

Typically one contestant per club unless otherwise approved by the club.

HOW THE CONTEST WORKS

- Contest begins at the club level
- Club top fundraiser advances to the district competition
- District winners advance to the state level
- Highest state fundraiser is crowned **State King or Queen**

FUNDRAISING GUIDELINES

How are funds counted?

Funds must be tracked and submitted according to NCASCC guidelines.

Do clubs/districts benefit?

Yes! Each contestant retains **1/3 of funds raised for their club/district**.
Remaining funds support NCASCC initiatives.

Fundraising expectations

All fundraising must be ethical, transparent, and aligned with NCASCC values.

ADVANCEMENT

Contestants advance based on highest verified fundraising totals.

Tie-breaking

Handled by contest officials if needed.

RECOGNITION

Winners may receive crowns, sashes, certificates, and special recognition.

TRANSPARENCY

Totals are verified by the Treasurer or designated officials.
Clubs are encouraged to track progress.
