

How quickly life changed for John the Baptist, two weeks ago we celebrated the Baptism of Jesus by him, last week He identifies Jesus as the Lamb of God, a new covenant not sealed in the blood of a lamb, the covenant this is body which is for you and this is my blood poured out for you. Now John is arrested, but he has already started the motion of the Messiah remember the Holt Spirit descended upon Jesus at his baptism; "this is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." Priests and Deacons know that each and every time we baptize with Water we are also baptizing with the Spirit of God we call the Holy Spirit down upon the Water when we bless it. Ever wonder why the Holy Spirit is depicted as a dove. It was a dove Noah released to see if there was dry land and when it returned with the Olive Branch and Noah knew there was dry land because an olive tree was growing. I read a story once that said the Dove was the most colorful bird, all the colors of the rainbow. When Noah asked if any of the birds would leave the Ark to see if there was dry land, one by one all species of birds came up with excuses as to why they couldn't, but not the Dove. After flying through the rain and finding the dry land as it returned to the Ark all the birds and other animals looked in disbelief, the Dove lost all its color. The Dove didn't care, he was relieved that he could return to the Ark with the message there was dry land, losing his color was a small price. Like the Doves announcement at Jesus Baptism by John, we should strive to be pleasing to God in though, word, and deed.





Instead, you are invited to come to the altar during the Lamb of God and are asked to stand on the opposite side of the altar from the Eucharistic Ministers to receive the low gluten eucharist before common distribution begins.
