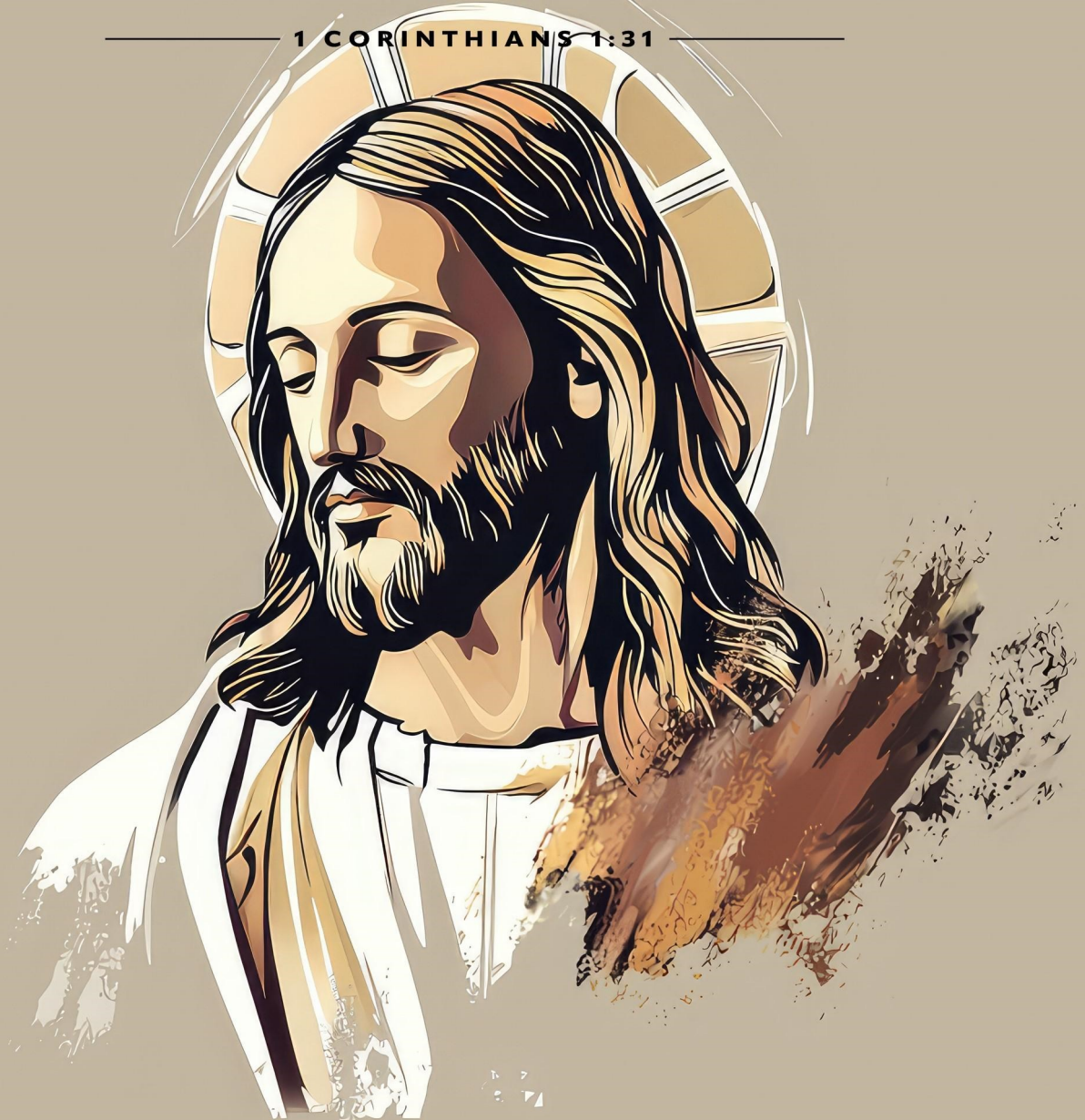

"As a Roman Catholic faith community, we seek to follow the example of St. Veronica who carried the image of Christ always with her. Through fellowship, service and acts of mercy we walk as disciples in Christ's mission together seeking an ever-deeper relationship with God through prayer, education, sacraments, and the celebration of the Eucharist."

This Sunday we have the Beatitudes to ponder. As a priest often times this Gospel fits well into a funeral because the deceased was one, or maybe more than one of the Beatitudes. You see they are about being rather than doing. Being a peacemaker means all time not just when others are being peaceful. Poor in spirit? Don't see to many ads that focus on being poor in spirit. Most advertising relates to self inflation rather than selflessness that we are called to. The poor in spirit are promised the kingdom of heaven. Not at the end of life but now. In the Lords prayer we say thy kingdom come thy will be done on earth as it is heaven. YOU are the one who decides whether you bring the kingdom of God here to earth if you are humble- poor in spirit. The late Pope Francis visited Sweden in 2016 and on the fest of All Saints day, when the Gospel of the beatitudes is also used in addition to this 4th Sunday, he offered 6 beatitudes for our Reflection. Sweden is 1% Catholic. They say 20-22% of Americans are Catholic. Hopefully they are able to live out the Beatitudes of Jesus and the following as well.

"Blessed are those who remain faithful while enduring evils inflicted on them by others and forgive them from their heart."

"Blessed are those who look into the eyes of the abandoned and marginalized and show them their closeness."

"Blessed are those who see God in every person and strive to make others also discover him."

"Blessed are those who protect and care for our common home."

"Blessed are those who renounce their own comfort in order to help others."

"Blessed are those who pray and work for full communion between Christians."

May God continue to Bless our Saint Veronica Community, I am writing this during a snowstorm, Father Francis Conroy will hopefully be back at Regina Cleri by the time you read this bulletin. And hopefully by the next bulletin our Shepherd Father Mahoney will have returned.

CRUCIFIX ON THE HILL

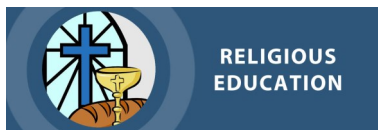

Instead, you are invited to come to the altar during the Lamb of God and are asked to stand on the opposite side of the altar from the Eucharistic Ministers to receive the low gluten eucharist before common distribution begins.
