The following Mission Statement was created by the Parish Council of St. Veronica Parish.

"As a Roman Catholic faith community, we seek to follow the example of St. Veronica who carried the image of Christ always with her. Through fellowship, service and acts of mercy we walk as disciples in Christ's mission together seeking an ever-deeper relationship with God through prayer, education, sacraments, and the celebration of the Eucharist."

Dear Saint Veronica Parishioners,

"Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus askes the man "what is written in the Law?" The man is caught and responds with Deuteronomy 6:5. This verse is one of the most important prayers in Judaism, and it was said twice a day in Jesus' time. Love of God and love of neighbor are what is required for eternal life. Jesus' response is simple, "Do this and you will live." "Who is my neighbor" is the next question. Jesus' response to that question is probably the most famous parable in all the gospels – the parable of the Good Samaritan. Samaritans were the most hated neighbor of the Israelites. The hated enemy is the compassionate neighbor in this parable. "Who is my neighbor?" The response turns the question around and takes up the deeper question: "How do I let the mercy and love of God that is in me shine on the world around me?" A neighbor is a person who acts with compassion and mercy toward another. The point becomes not who deserves to be loved as I love myself, but that I become a person who treats everyone with compassion and mercy.

I saw this on the internet and thought it would be good to share. Thought provoking. A young couple moved into a new neighborhood. The next morning while they were eating breakfast, the young woman saw her neighbor hanging the washing outside. "That laundry is not very clean; she doesn't know how to wash correctly. Perhaps she needs better laundry soap." Her husband looked on, remaining silent. Every time her neighbor hung her washing out to dry, the young woman made the same comments. A month later, the woman was surprised to see a nice clean wash on the line and said to her husband, "Look, she's finally learned how to wash correctly. I wonder who taught her this?" The husband replied, "I got up early this morning and cleaned our windows." And so it is with life... What we see when watching others depends on the clarity of the window through which we look. So don't be too quick to judge others, especially if your perspective of life is clouded by anger, jealousy, negativity or unfulfilled desires. "Judging a person does not define who they are. It defines who you are."

The Catholic Appeal is going well here in Burlington. Thank you for your efforts! We still have a way to go, but I am confident we will reach our goals. The funding is essential to the running of the Archdiocese. It also supports us at the local parish level. To date we have raised \$74,865. Our financial goal is \$100,300. Our "Assessment Goal" i.e. the Goal we are <u>required</u> to collect is \$81,216. We need to raise \$6,351 to reach our Assessment. If we do not make our Assessment, the Archdiocese will simply take it out of our savings account. Please be generous. Once we make our Assessment, we will receive a refund. We are very close. Thank you to all who have already given.

The Summer Vacation Season is upon us. All of us at St. Veronica Parish hope that you have a restful and enjoyable summer vacation wherever you may find yourself. We sincerely thank our parishioners who mail or deliver your weekly envelopes to the Parish Offices while you are out-of-town on vacation. 


