Dear Saint Veronica Parishioners,

Last two Sunday's Gospels show Jesus instructing his disciples on how to be ready for the coming judgment. We are not to be like the greedy rich fool. We are, rather, to share our wealth with those in need. We are also to be watchful and to be living in such a way that we are ready right now to meet our Creator. In today's Gospel, Jesus is totally involved in his mission to save us. Fire is the image he uses to speak of this great desire in his heart. He wants our faith to be set on fire so that we can be His Disciples in Mission. Jesus also knows that not everyone will receive his message and it would bring division at a deep level in many relationships. This was very true in the time of Jesus as it is today. Jesus does not set out to cause conflict, but his message is so radical that it does cause division in certain situations and relationships. The Gospel is a call to conversion, to becoming 'a new creation' (2 Corinthians 5:17). It means shedding the skin of a former way of living. How am I living my faith today? Does it challenge others?



There are two main changes to note this year:

Family of Faith: Grades 1, 3-5

Once a month, children in grades 1, 3-5 will gather for a Family of Faith gathering beginning with the 10am Mass, followed by donuts and a teaching. At these sessions, children will gather in age-level groups for a lesson/activity related to the month's topic. Parents should attend Mass with their children, and will have the option to stay and enjoy a cup of coffee with other parents during the teaching.

Confirmation

We will be Confirming students in grades 8th and 9th this year. 8th and 9th graders will have the option of attending a Monday night session or a Wednesday afternoon session.

We are always looking for people to volunteer with our programs in various ways. We need help particularly with Wednesday afternoons (2-3:30) and Monday nights (7-8:15). There are a lot of kids in the school building during these times and we need adults present for crowd control, hall monitoring, as well as adults to teach lessons. 

the National Shrine of The Divine Mercy in Stockbridge, Massachusetts.

Situated on 375 acres known as Eden Hill, the Shrine is owned and administered by the Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception. The artwork and relics throughout the Shrine express two key elements of the identity and mission of the Marians —the Immaculate Conception and Divine Mercy.

At the Shrine, you can walk the grounds, pray the Stations of the Cross, and visit the Lourdes Grotto, the Shrine of the Holy Innocents, and the many other memorials and shrines. You are also encouraged to experience Jesus' mercy in the daily prayer activities: Confession, Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, the Rosary, and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.

Our bus will be departing St. Malachy parking lot at 8:00am and will arrive at the Shrine at 10:30. We will spend the entire day on site. Parishioners invited to bring along a sack lunch or purchase lunch on site. Participants will be encouraged to come together for Mass at 2:00pm and The Chaplet of the Divine Mercy and Benediction at 3:00. Bus will depart for home around 4:00pm.

Cost for the trip is \$75 per person. **Each participant is asked to contribute \$40** towards this fee with the additional cost covered by the parish, however **financial assistance is available** for anyone upon request. No one will miss this opportunity due to financial burden.
