Dear St. Veronica Parishioners,

I always like to say that perspective is a wonderful thing. Many years ago, a friend of mine sent me the following vignette -

One day, the father of a very wealthy family took his son on a trip to the country with the express purpose of showing him how poor people live. They spent a couple of days and nights on the farm of what would be considered a very poor family. On their return from their trip, the father asked his son, 'How was the trip?'

'It was great, Dad.'

'Did you see how poor people live?' the father asked.

'Oh yeah,' said the son.

'So, tell me, what did you learn from the trip?' asked the father.

The son answered:

'I saw that we have one dog and they had four.

We have a pool that reaches to the middle of our garden and they have a creek that has no end.

We have imported lanterns in our garden and they have the stars at night.

Our patio reaches to the front yard and they have the whole horizon.

We have a small piece of land to live on and they have fields that go beyond our sight. We have servants who serve us, but they serve others.

We buy our food, but they grow theirs. We have walls around our property to protect us, they have friends to protect them.' The boy's father was speechless. Then his son added, 'Thanks Dad for showing me how poor we are.'

It's so important to maintain a sense of perspective in our lives. We live in a society which is constantly sending out a message that is self-centered and materialistic. We are forever being told to get more, to do our own thing. It is a message that is very attractive and easy to get caught up in. But, is also a message that is decidedly anti-Christian and entirely inconsistent with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

That's why it is so important to step back every once in a while and take the time to reflect on and appreciate what should be the most important things in our lives — family and friends, and, most importantly, our relationship with God.

Having a sense of perspective gives us the ability to see that it's better to center our lives on Christ, rather than on ourselves. It allows us to step outside of ourselves and take a broader view of life and realize that the richness of life is in life itself, and not of the things we can acquire; that true freedom comes not from the power to do anything we want, but from the humility to do what is right and good; that true happiness comes not from having everything that we want, but, rather, from everything we need.

Having a sense of perspective gives us the ability to see that real wealth lies not in the limited goods available in this world, but, rather, the limitless riches that come from life in Christ.



Saint Cecilia

ecilia has been honored as a martyr since about 545.
According to a written legend, The Passion of Saint
Cecilia, she was a Roman Christian of the patrician class
betrothed to the pagan Valerian. The Cecilia Passion has her
singing to God in her heart on her wedding day. Cecilia tells
Valerian she has made a vow of virginity and persuades him to
convert to Christianity and enter into a celibate marriage. His
brother, Tiburtius, also becomes a Christian. The brothers are
later martyred. When Cecilia refuses to perform an idolatrous
act, she too is martyred. Cecilia is the patron of musicians.

This young Roman martyr invites believers to be watchful on their journey toward the encounter with Christ, gladdening the earthly pilgrimage with the festivity of music and song.
