Cricket Australia Masters Inc (CAM) is seeking nominations for **two Director positions** on the CAM Board. Directors hold specific portfolios and contribute to the strategic governance of CAM at the national level. This is an opportunity for members with relevant skills and experience to make a significant contribution to the future of masters cricket in Australia.

Key Responsibilities

- Contribute to board-level decision-making and strategic planning
- Take responsibility for a specific Director portfolio (see below)
- Represent CAM's interests in matters related to their portfolio
- Work constructively with fellow Board members, the Advisory Group, and CAM staff
- Attend Board meetings and contribute to sub-committees as required

Director Portfolios

Nominees should indicate their preferred portfolio(s) in their nomination statement. The four portfolios are:

Director – Governance & Strategy	Strategic planning, board governance, compliance, risk management, and oversight of CAM's cricket policy framework including liaison with State and Territory bodies.
Director – Finance & Operations	Financial oversight, budgeting, operational management, program delivery, and technology.
Director – Stakeholder Engagement & Partnerships	Relationships with clubs, players, State and Territory bodies, national bodies, sponsors, and funding bodies.
Director – Communications & Marketing	Brand management, digital presence, social media, and member communications.

Skills & Experience

- Skills and experience relevant to one or more of the Director portfolios
- Capacity to contribute to board-level governance in a volunteer capacity
- Understanding of the national masters cricket environment
- Demonstrated commitment to the values and objectives of CAM

Election / Appointment Process

Two Directors are elected by the CAM Advisory Group from nominations received from the membership. Nominees should indicate in their nomination statement which portfolio(s) they are best suited to.

Eligibility

To be eligible for nomination, candidates must:

- Be a financial member of Cricket Australia Masters Inc or a member association.
- Not be disqualified from managing a corporation under the Corporations Act 2001.
- Not have had their membership of CAM Inc terminated in the previous two years.

Nomination Process

- Nominations must be submitted in writing to the CAM Secretary.
- Nominations must include the nominee's written consent.
- Nominations must be endorsed by the nominee's State or Territory member organisation.
- Nominations must include a brief statement of the nominee's relevant experience and qualifications.
- Nominations close at **COB on Thursday 23 July**.
