



Veterans Cricket Australia – Hall of Fame Criteria.

1. Purpose.

The purpose of entry into the Hall of Fame is to recognise five (5) or more years of service to Veterans Cricket Australia by way of “Demonstrated outstanding achievement either on the cricket field or in administration or a combination of both”.

2. Nominated persons.

A nominated person is eligible for consideration as an inductee into the Hall of Fame after a member nominates that person for Hall of Fame entry.

The nominating person is requested to complete the Hall of Fame nomination form in support of that nomination. (Refer to separate form)

A nominated person’s outstanding service as a player and/or administrator of Veterans Cricket Australia will be evaluated within the following guide lines.

- I. The nominee has been a highly successful player over a minimum of 5 years playing for Australia as acknowledged by his/her peers and supported by match statistics.
- II. The nominee may have captained VCA teams in ODI matches and teams on overseas tours.
- III. The nominee has been conspicuously seen by the members in their execution of duties as a successful administrator towards the betterment of Veterans Cricket Australia for a period in excess of 5 years.
- IV. The administrative service shall be outstanding in nature and not directly for status or kudos and definitely not for personal gain, or profit.
- V. A combination of the above attributes may result in a player with slightly less than “highly successful” results but with “success” as an administrator or vice versa being eligible for consideration.
- VI. The character, personal standing and behaviour of the nominated person shall be beyond reproach.

3. Awards Committee.

VCA shall appoint an Awards Committee. The Awards Committee shall comprise of a minimum of 3 persons with the President or nominee as Chair of the Committee. (The Board may consider appointing a Life Member or Hall of Fame Inductee to this committee at an appropriate time.) The primary purpose of the Awards Committee is to consider, and where appropriate, make recommendations on Awards to the Board. Any nomination for a Hall of Fame entry shall be forwarded to the VCA secretary.

4. Selection protocol

The Awards Committee shall judge the relative merits and contributions towards “Demonstrated outstanding achievement either on the cricket field or in administration or a combination of both to VCA”. The following guidelines shall apply to the nominated person or persons,

1. The Awards Committee shall review each nomination independently and determine whether the nominated person meets the guidelines.
2. A Hall of Fame Inductee can only be awarded if the required guidelines are met.
3. Eligibility for Hall of Fame entry does not entitle a person to Hall of Fame entry automatically.
4. The Awards Committee members shall reach consensus on any recommendation for Hall of Fame entry.
- 5 The endorsement of a Hall of Fame Inductee is solely the decision of the Board and no correspondence will be entered into. The approval of Hall of Fame entry is a decision of the Board of VCA based on a recommendation received from the Awards Committee.

5. Benefits and Recognition for Hall of Fame Inductees.

Hall of Fame Inductees shall have their name recorded on the official Hall of Fame register. Hall of Fame Inductees may be presented at the AGM, or a suitable function held by VCA.
