

HALL OF FAME CRITERIA

Purpose

The purpose of entry into the Hall of Fame is to recognise five (5) or more years of service to Cricket Australia Masters (CAM) by way of “Demonstrated outstanding achievement either on the cricket field or in administration, or a combination of both”.

Nominated Persons

A nominated person, or nominee, is eligible for consideration as an inductee into the Hall of Fame after a member nominates that person for Hall of Fame entry.

The Nominator is requested to complete the Hall of Fame Nomination Form in support of that nomination. Refer to separate form.

A Nominee’s outstanding service as a player and/or administrator of CAM will be evaluated within the following guidelines:

- A. The nominee has been a highly successful player over a minimum of 5 years playing for Australia as acknowledged by his/her peers and supported by match statistics.
- B. The nominee may have captained CAM teams in Australia and overseas.
- C. The nominee has been conspicuously seen by members in their execution of duties as a successful administrator towards the betterment of CAM for a period in excess of 5 years.
- D. The administrative service shall be outstanding in nature and not directly for status or kudos and definitely not for personal gain, or profit.
- E. A combination of the above attributes may result in a player with slightly less than “highly successful” results but with “success” as an administrator or vice versa being eligible for consideration.
- F. The character, personal standing and behaviour of the nominee shall be beyond reproach.

Awards Committee

CAM shall appoint an Awards Committee. The Awards Committee shall comprise of a minimum of 3 persons with the President or nominee as Chair of the committee. The Board may consider appointing a Life Member or Hall of Fame Inductee to this committee at an appropriate time. The primary purpose of the Awards Committee is to consider, and where appropriate, make recommendations on Award to the Board. Selection Protocol

The Awards Committee shall judge the relative merits and contributions towards “demonstrated outstanding achievement either on the cricket field or in administration, or a combination of both to CAM”. The following guidelines shall apply to the nominee/s:

1. The Awards Committee shall review each nomination independently and determine whether the nominee meets the guidelines.
2. A Hall of Fame Inductee can only be awarded if the required guidelines are met.
3. Eligibility for Hall of Fame entry does not entitle a person to Hall of Fame entry automatically.
4. The Awards Committee members shall each reach consensus on any recommendation for Hall of Fame entry.
5. The endorsement of a Hall of Fame Inductee is solely the decision of the Awards Committee, and no correspondence shall be entered into. The approval of Hall of Fame entry is a decision of the Board of CAM, based on a recommendation received from the Awards Committee.

Recognition for Hall of Fame Inductees

Hall of Fame Inductees shall receive a suitable, tangible recognition of their award, and have their name recorded on the official Hall of Fame register, maintained by the Secretary. Hall of Fame Inductees may be presented at a suitable function.

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
