Since our founding, we've believed in fair and transparent pricing and have always disclosed our pricing in person and online. This brochure provides our itemized pricing for a wide array of services we can provide, as well as caskets and outer burial containers.

In 1984, the federal government began regulating all funeral homes through the Federal Trade Commission when it implemented the "Funeral Rule" and mandated itemized price lists that must be presented before you make any specific selections.

Prior to 1984, at most funeral homes you selected the casket and included in the casket price was everything the funeral home offered which normally included embalming, one, two or even three days of viewing, the hearse and limousine to the cemetery...creating an "all or nothing" price which required families to pay for things they didn't need or may not have even wanted.

Much like a restaurant ala carte menu, itemization allows you the freedom to choose the things that you need, but we understand that it can be confusing as well. To simplify the planning process, we've created packaged plans that include the most commonly selected services together with allowances for merchandise. These popular plans are featured in our *Funeral & Cremation Options* brochure, as well as on our website at: www.MichiganCremation.com, and often offer a greater savings over our already very affordable itemized pricing.

We believe that you should be able to pay your respects without spending your life savings. Families should have the freedom to choose the services they want and should never be pressured into paying for things they don't want or need. FOR *Veterans* AND THEIR FAMILIES



Helping Veterans and their families is a part of our founding mission. Our entire staff has been specially trained on caring for Veterans. From the moment we transfer your loved one into our care, determining eligibility for veteran's benefits, to the final sounding of "Taps," we'll guide you every step of the way.



Our staff, which is comprised of Veterans and the children and grandchildren of Veterans, will help with paperwork and applications, obtaining the burial flag, arranging for free burial in a National Cemetery, and coordinating military honors. And unlike other mortuaries and cemeteries, there is no additional cost to you or your family. We take great pride in serving those who served.



Veterans Benefits We make obtaining Veterans benefits simple. Just provide a copy of the Veteran's discharge and we'll handle all the often confusing details of obtaining benefits. Our staff will complete the applications and forms, including reimbursements that the family may be eligible for, as well as obtaining a burial flag, a Presidential Memorial Certificate, and government grave marker (if desired). We can even assist with obtaining a duplicate copy of the discharge paperwork if you're unable to locate.

Military Honors Our staff will coordinate military honors, which at a minimum consists of at least two uniformed members from the Veteran's branch of service who will fold and present the burial flag and sound "Taps." If desired and available, a final rifle salute from a volunteer Veterans Service Organization can often be arranged. We also work closely with the Michigan Patriot Guard Riders to provide flag lines and motorcycle escorts.



Free Burial in a National Cemetery Almost all honorably discharged Veterans who served in our Armed Forces - in times of war or peace - are eligible for burial or entombment in a National Cemetery. The National Cemetery Administration will provide the grave, opening and closing, a concrete graveliner (vault) for casketed burial, perpetual care, and a grave marker at no cost. The spouse and dependent children of a Veteran are also eligible. The value of this benefit can easily exceed \$10,000 when compared to local private cemeteries.

Retire Your Flag the Dignified Way While Honoring a Veteran Whenever we cremate a Veteran, the body is draped with a retired American Flag that is no longer suitable for display (worn, soiled, faded, tattered or torn). We believe this not only honors the Veteran in death, but is also the most respectful way to retire the American Flag. We gladly accept donations of retired flags.

General Price List

These prices are effective as of July 1, 2025, but thereafter subject to change without notice. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL FEES

Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff.....\$995

Our fee for the "Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff" includes, but is not limited to: staff available to respond to initial request for service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week; consultation with staff by telephone, facsimile, or internet communication up to 15 minutes; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; and recording of vital statistics including notification to Social Security Administration and filing of death certificate with local county clerk. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding, or receiving of remains.

Coordination of Arrangements..... \$200

Our fee for "Coordination of Arrangements" may include professional services that are not included in the above "Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff" charge such as: a formal planning conference; consultation with the family, clergy, musician, etc.; coordinating arrangement details with the cemetery or crematory or other third-parties involved in the service, ceremony, or event; assistance in creating and publishing obituaries and death notices (not including actual publication costs and fees); and staff assistance prior to and following the service, ceremony, or event.

Embalming.....\$795

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Direct Cremation (Range of Prices) **\$3,490 to \$1,995**

Our charge for a direct cremation (without viewing, visitation, or ceremonies) includes: transfer of the body from any local medical facility, sheltering of the remains (up to 48 hours), minimal services of the funeral director and staff, obtaining required authorizations, and transfer of the remains to the custody of the crematorium (standard crematory fee is included). If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. *Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The most basic (minimal) container we provide is constructed of corrugated materials.*

Cemetery fees and expenses are additional, as well as an outer burial container if required by the cemetery.*

PAYMENT POLICY

We realize that losing someone you love is a devastating experience. It can be traumatic and influence the decisions that must be made. Therefore, it is important to be realistic with respect to funeral expenses. It is our intent that your decisions reflect your personal wishes and remain within your budget. We believe that a life well-lived is worth remembering. We will assist you in creating a meaningful and personal tribute for your loved one. For your convenience, we accept the following methods of payment at the time of arrangement:

- Cash or Check • Credit Card (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover)
- Verified Life Insurance Assignment (a 5% processing fee, minimum of \$200, will be added to the entire contract amount for all life insurance policy assignments).

We are unable to bill the estate of the deceased, as probate and trust matters can often last months or years before final settlement. All financial arrangements are made with the purchaser, and not with the estate of your loved one. Under Michigan probate code, the person who pays the funeral expenses is allowed to file a claim against the estate for reimbursement.

CASH ADVANCES

Upon your request, we will include the charges of third-parties that may be involved in the service, ceremony, or event for a fee. Cash advances are typically charges that are due at the time services are rendered such as honorariums for clergy, musicians, and vocalists, cemetery or crematory fees, newspaper obituaries and death notices, catering and luncheons, etc. A 5% cash advance accommodation fee may be added to our statement for those items unless payment in full is made by cash or check at the time of arrangements.

Casket Price List

Prices effective July 1, 2025 but thereafter are subject to change without notice.

The casket is often the visual and emotional focal point of the ceremony. When selecting a casket, the first decision is typically the material it's manufactured from – wood or metal. Wood caskets have a natural warmth and beauty, resemble fine furniture, and are hand crafted from a renewable resource. Metal caskets have a wider range of choices in color and paint finishes, which in addition to the metal gauge (thickness), influence the cost.

Cremation Caskets are specially designed to be fully combustible, and may also be suitable for burial. They are made with minimal metal content, and are usually selected when a public viewing, visitation or ceremony is planned prior to cremation. **Alternative Containers** are often constructed of composite materials such as corrugated cardboard, have a modest appearance, and are usually selected when no viewing or ceremonies are planned. Both encase the body, are cremated with your loved one, and satisfy the crematorium's standards for rigidity, combustibility, and leak resistance.

If choosing casketed burial in a National Cemetery, we will arrange for an outer burial container to be provided at no cost to the family.

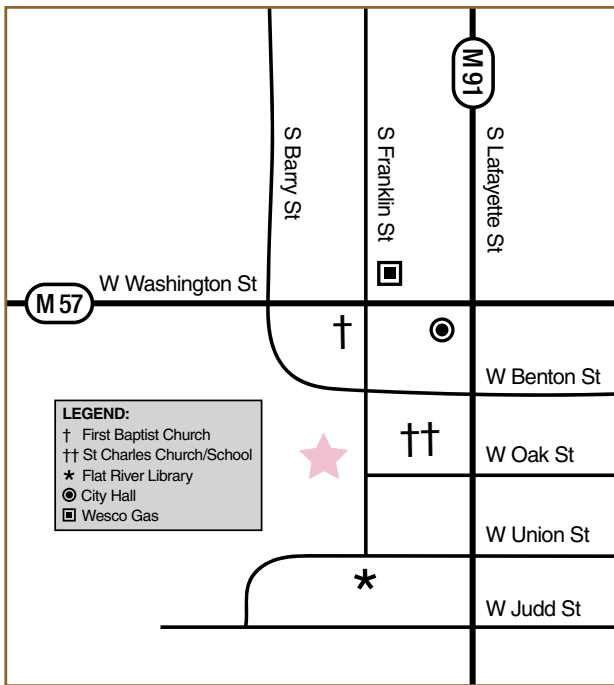
