

Role:

Marriage Catechumenate Liaison

Purpose:

This person will work within a specific deanery in collaboration with the Dean and Deanery Chairperson to achieve the goals that have been determined by the deanery committee regarding implementation of the Marriage Catechumenate.

Tasks/Actions:

- Articulate the Diocese of Cleveland's vision for the Marriage Catechumenate-appropriate to specific deanery realities.
- Serve as a liaison between the Dean or Deanery Chairperson, the parishes, and the Office of Marriage and Family Ministry.
- Assess effectiveness of ongoing strategies towards the adoption of the guidelines for the Marriage Catechumenate and the formation of marriage ministries.
- Identify the particular needs of parishes and brainstorm/guide potential solutions.
- Coordinate deanery-wide calendar of marriage enrichment events and marriage mentoring assignments.

Potential Selection Criteria:

- Catholic in good standing
- Articulate
- Creative problem-solver
- Passionate about marriage, supporting couples, (and the implementation of the marriage catechumenate)
- Clergy or LEM preferred but not mandatory
