## **III. THE FEI CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE:**

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriering and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

**VII. ENTRIES:**

Definite Entries: **Tuesday, 24/02/2026 at 12:00 PM**

Late Entries: **LATE ENTRIES NOT PERMITTED**

- Entry fee per combination competing: **10KD/- \*\***

- **This fee covers one rider per test**, each level consists of two tests except for the TL
  - Riders have the option to ride ONE Test per level if they wish
  - The Test number to be ridden **MUST** be Mentioned in the Entry Sheet submitted. If NOT, the OC will put the riders' entry in the first test by default

- **The Competition has a maximum number of tests per day and due to Ramadan limited Timings**, if the number is exceeded the following could happen:

1. TEST 2 in the Basic Level will be cancelled, and a refund will be given to the rider
2. Some levels might shift in days according to start list load in each level to accommodate the maximum number of riders
3. In Training Level, priority will be given to riders who did not qualify to Basic Level and New Entries

**VIII. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

**1. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY:**

The number of athletes required to present themselves for the prize-giving ceremony per level:

- Up to 6 Participants: 3 Riders
- Up to 9 Participants: 4 Riders
- Up to 12 Participants: 5 Riders
- 12+ Participants: 6 Riders

- **A minimum of 1 point (Score 60% and above) is required to be eligible for prize giving**
