Observance of Divine Mercy Sunday will include Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at noon and Benediction at 3 p.m. Father James will announce any further details.

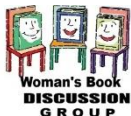


The Knights of Columbus are hosting breakfast after Mass this Sunday, April 12th. We hope to see you there!
