\$3 MILLION | \$1.5 MILLION IN LEGACY GIFTS

The future of our Church relies on the ministry of priests, and the Diocese of Cheyenne is committed to nurturing vocations. Through the *Communion for Mission* campaign, we aim to raise \$3 million to support seminarian education and development, with an additional \$1.5 million in legacy gifts.

Supporting one seminarian costs approximately \$68,000 annually, covering everything from tuition to travel. Currently, we have four seminarians and hope to see that number grow. Our youth ministry engages young people in discerning their call, fostering the next generation of leaders.

Let us respond to God's call, as John 15:16 reminds us: "It was not you who chose me, but I who chose you." Together, we can ensure a vibrant future for our parishes.
