These priests have celebrated Mass, preached the Gospel, and provided comfort in our sorrows. Even in retirement, they continue to enrich our community by leading retreats and visiting the sick.

Now, it's our turn to support them. Upon retirement, priests lose their salary and housing, relying on the St. Joseph's Society, Social Security, and personal savings. Our goal is to raise \$1.3 million in the next five years to increase their retirement benefit from 86.81% to 100% of a priest's salary after 40 years of service, plus an additional \$2 million in legacy gifts.
