introduce yourself to those you don't know.



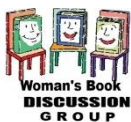
NEW ALTAR SERVER

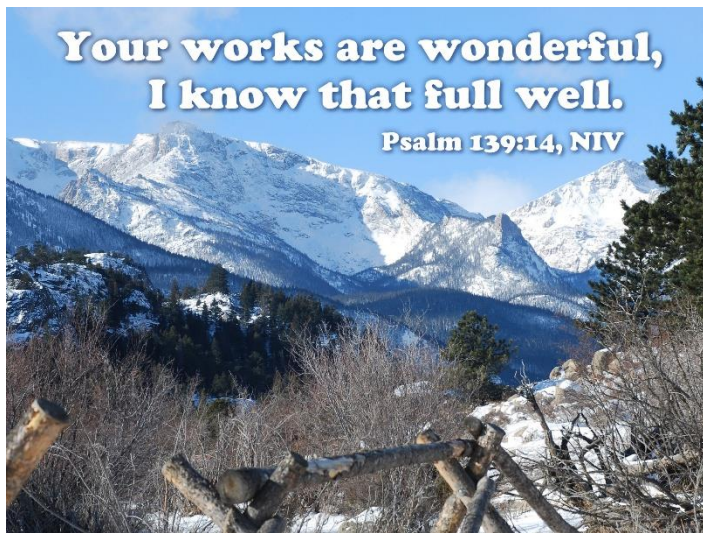
