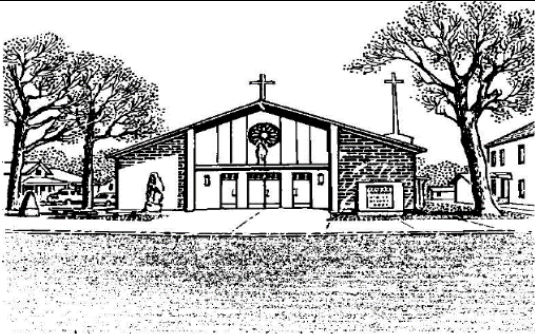

The Parish Council met on October 16, 2025. The approved minutes from the September 25th meeting are on the bulletin board in the back of the church.



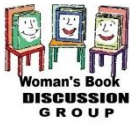
CONGRATULATIONS!

\$506,070 has been pledged towards Communion For Mission by our parishioners. This is 131% of our goal. Thank you! As St.

Barbara's has met the Communion for Mission goal, we are now able to receive 50% of the donations towards this fundraiser for our own Bathroom Addition Project. As of today, we will get back \$117,585. (This amount includes the \$38,700 that is subtracted to pay the fundraising company) The Building Committee is planning the next steps towards starting this project. We will update you in the process as we move forward.
