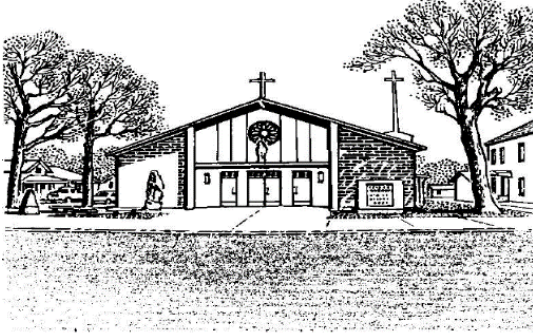

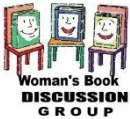
Parish Directory Pictures: Your final opportunity to have your photo in the Parish Directory will be after Sunday morning Mass
