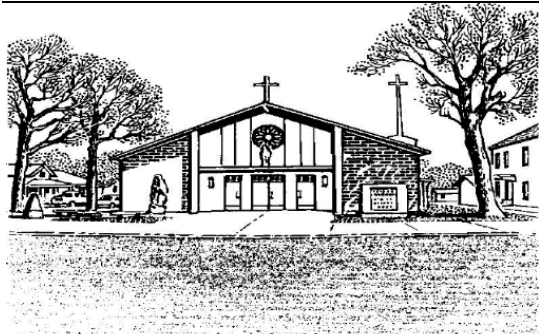

introduce yourself to those you don't know.



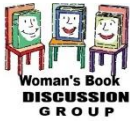

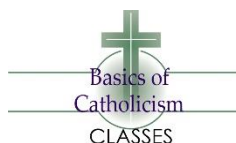
