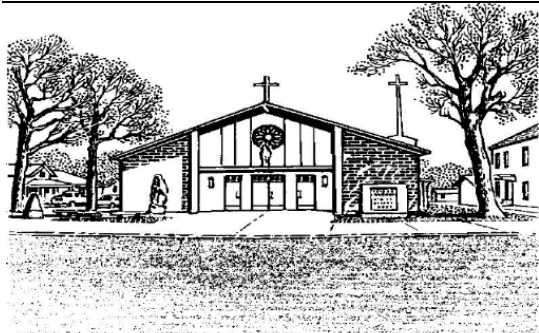

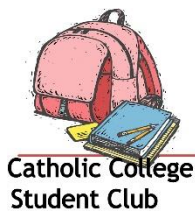
Please join us for breakfast after the 9:00 a.m. mass on **Sunday, September 13**. We will be serving ham and cheese omelets, fruit, and toast.
