JUBILEE YEAR RETREAT FOUR

All are welcome to attend the fourth Jubilee Year Pilgrims of Hope Retreat on Saturday, September 27, 2025, at Saint Patrick Church, Casper, beginning at 9 am, and closing with Mass at 5 pm. The retreat focuses on hope for peace in the world and migrants. This theme coincides with *Spes Non Confundit*, paragraphs 8 and 13. Bishop Steven will open the retreat by discussing hope and the sources of hope: Word of God, Holy Spirit, Paschal Mystery, and Saints of Hope. Participants will join in Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction, and engage in the Spiritual Conversation and a Mercy Hour. This will be a bilingual retreat, and lunch will be provided.
