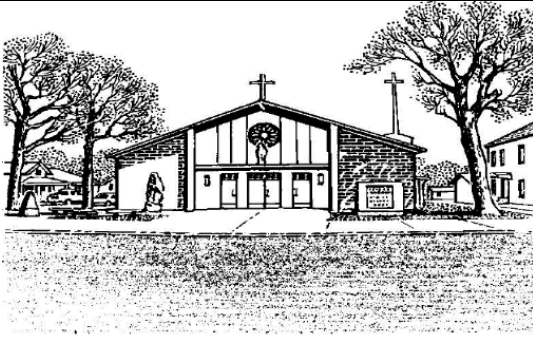

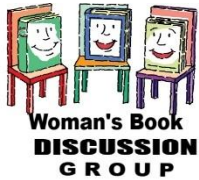
FINANCIAL UPDATE: There will be two financial reports available for parishioners to view each year. One will be the year-end report for June 30, 2025. 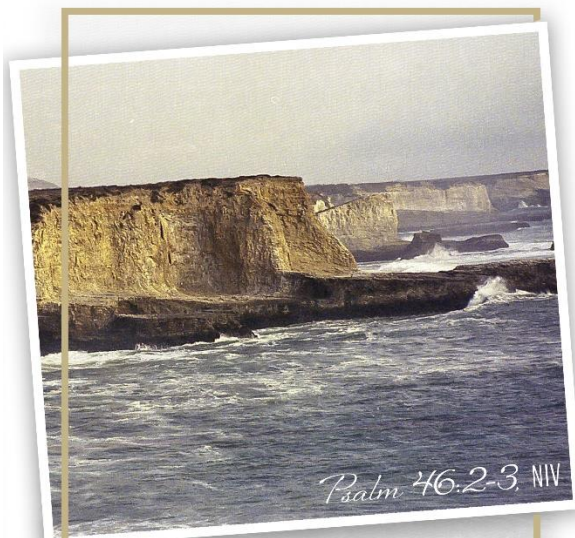
