The Attack truck A131 was delivered to AMI-FIRE Equipment in Brenham Texas to begin the conversion from an 800 gallon brush truck to an 1800 gallon brush truck/tanker. The conversion will require about five months to complete depending on the availability of the larger tank.

The 3000 gallon tanker T131 that had been in Mississippi at the Deep South Fire Equipment manufacturer for the last several months was returned with the leaking tank repaired.

A meeting was held with the USArmy corp of engineers to discuss the fire hazard possed by the high grass along the fence line between White Bluff Resort and the Corp property. The Corp presented an agreement contract in which the POA would be allowed to cut the grass up to 35 feet back from the

fence line all around the resort property at POA expense. A representative of the POA was at the meeting but no agreement was stated.

Firefighter Ethan Watson completed the EMT classes and received a State of Texas License as an EMT. This was a school paid for by the department to improve our medical response capabilities.
