Brush Truck 331 remains in the shop completing the replacement of all grass fighting equipment on the back of the truck. It will be a full diesel-powered pump with a 400-gallon water tank when it is returned.

Update on the delivery is within the next two weeks. This work was covered under one of the Forest Service Grants the department received.

The second 3000-gallon tanker is scheduled to be delivered to the department by the end of September. This was also financed by a grant from the Forest Service and greatly improves our total water available on the scene of a fire in the White Bluff Resort.

July 4th the department again provided two brush trucks during the fireworks show to be prepared in the event of a firework misfire and the department boat was deployed.

Meetings have been held with the POA concerning the land swap for a new fire station. Information was also gathered on the timeline of architectural design, grant financing and building the structure.

The Emergency Service District #1 has a new director appointed by the County Judge. This will result in a quorum so that business and meeting can resume.

We are still needing additional members for the department to be full strength.
