- Meeting between FD, members of POA board and Corp of Engineers to discuss issue of high fire danger due to dry grass close to WB property.
- Firefighter Ethan Watson has completed his EMT training and passed his State and National test and is now a licensed EMT.

- White Bluff VFD may get a grant for a new tanker from Tx Forestry. Will know for sure later in October.
- Bill advised he requested money from the FD Capital Expenditure fund kept by the POA
- Terry Pierce advised that so far for the live auction we have a fire pit from St Peter's, an 11x14 portrait sitting and print, a condo stay in Puerto Vallarta for a week and a Yeti cooler from Siddons-Martin and asked if firefighters would like to add a favorite beverage to include in cooler.
