Work on two of the grants received from the Forest Service continues. Two companies were contacted for bids on the Slip-on unit grant to be used to update the pump, motor and plumbing on Brush 331. The 3000-gallon tanker that was

authorized by grant is being manufactured and should be delivered in a few months.

Our Attack truck is being converted into an 1800-gallon tanker/brush truck that should be returned to us in four weeks. This is the 700-gallon brush truck that suffered a complete failure of the compressor and pump. This new configuration will be much more usable for the department.
